An application to conduct exploration activities for CSG in the Tweed and Byron Shires has been lodged by the NSW Aboriginal Land Council.

Anybody who believes that the coastal and urbanised areas of the Tweed and Byron Shires are not under direct threat from CSG mining should think again.

Do you want Mullumbimby roads to be CSG/gas field free?

This is a public meeting organised by Mullumbimby residents. If the attendees declare their support, **we will survey Mullumbimby and surrounding areas.**

From Nashua through Eltham and up to the Queensland border, there is now a continuous band of territory declared Gasfield Free by citizens. More than 70 communities have done this grass-roots democracy process in each of the Northern Rivers local government areas. The average response rate to going Gasfield Free is 96%.
